With respect to the requests from all the Pharmacy Colleges offering Pharm- D and Pharm- D (Post Baccalaureate) courses, the University is pleased to permit the installation of the Biometric Attendance System (BAS) devices at their respective Hospital premises (i.e., Hospital with which the College had already entered into an MoU for conducting classes for PHARM-D and PHARM-D (PB) students) for the smooth running of the system. It is brought to the notice of the University that the students and faculty members belonging to Pharam-D and Pharm-D (PB) courses are able to give their respective biometric attendance only at the College premises and were unable to give biometric attendance at the Hospital premises leading to shortage of attendance as per University norms.

Hence, the Principals are hereby informed to make necessary arrangements for enabling the capturing of the biometric attendance of both students and faculty members and with the help of the concerned faculty member (incharge) / Nodal office to take care of the BAS device and see to it that all of them give their attendance twice a day (in and out) during their stay at the Hospital premises on those specific days.

Further, the Colleges are requested to submit the soft copies of the following to the University at the link provided at the respective **Dashboard** of the UAAC portal on or before **09-09-2019**:

1. Copy of the MoU with the concerned hospital
2. List of students studying PHARM-D and PHARM-D (PB) courses who will visit the Hospital alongwith time table and days of visit.
3. List of faculty members handling classes for PHARM-D and PHARM-D (PB) courses at the Hospital
4. Name of the Nodal officer (incharge) / faculty member in control of the BAS device installed at the Hospital
