I am to invite kind attention to the captioned subject. A copy of the reference first cited is sent herewith.

- 2. You are kindly aware that the Conference of Governors, 2019 was held at Rashtrapati Bhavan, New Delhi on 23rd–24th November, 2019. The Ministry of Home Affairs vide reference first cited has communicated summary of actionable recommendations of the Conference of Governors, extracted from the 'Gist of Proceedings' received from the President's Secretariat, pertaining to Governor's Secretariat / State Government.
- 3. I am directed to request to arrange to take necessary action complying with the following recommendations / advice:
- (1) Incorporation of Integrated Water Management course in the curriculum of Engineering Colleges (Recommendation/advice: Sri Parameshwar Aiyr, Secretary, Jal Shakti).
- (2) Positive engagement of youth in Fit India movement to keep them away from social evils and maladies (Hon'ble PM).
- (3) All labour-oriented works necessary for rainwater harvesting activities can be covered under MNREGA for which substantial funds are provided. To facilitate quick execution of rainwater harvesting activities, the use of machines and earth movers is necessary in certain areas (Hon'ble Governor, Tamil Nadu).
- (4) All universities should ensure Water harvesting and only solar electricity should be used there (Hon'ble Governor, Madhya Pradesh).
- (5) Measures should be taken by States to fight out the menace of going down of water level (Hon'ble Governor, Madhya Pradesh).
- (6) NAAC evaluation should be mandatory for Universities / Colleges which has been established for more than five years. Research thesis should mandatorily be uploaded on Shodh Ganga so as to stop plagiarism.

National internship portal should be made. Multi-storied buildings should be made inside the University campuses so as to minimise the land acquisition. To connect students with social cause, the concept of University Social Responsibility should be introduced. Job oriented courses should be included in the curriculum. Each University should have Industry Academia Exchange (Hon'ble Governor, Uttar Pradesh).

- (7) Involvement of community and students in policing to be encouraged. Separate law and order and investigating wings at police stations are needed (Hon'ble Governor, West Bengal).
- (8) Programs in Universities to be held on Constitution Day to imbibe the spirit of Constitutionalism (Hon'ble Minister of Law & Justice).
 - (9) All Universities can do a lot of things such as Introducing integrated water management system at Engineering Colleges; introducing summer internship; credit for monitoring of scheme; water budgeting exercise and grey water management for reuse and recharge in all campuses; adopting energy audit and reduce energy consumption using renewable source like solar; adopting nearby villages to ensure development; and management of sustainable water supply system (Hon'ble Governor, Tamil Nadu).
 - (10) All Universities should endeavour to promote publication of research papers in National and International magazines; promote culture of innovation and start up in the Universities; and organise 'Hekethon' like programmes at university level (Hon'ble PM).
 - (11) Under project works assigned to students by Universities / Agricultural Universities, students be asked to evaluate practices adopted by farmers and to suggest those practices which could be institutionalised (Hon'ble PM).
- (12) Identification of Backward Blocks which are far below the State parameters in the development index, to be notified as Aspirational Blocks on the same analogy as that of the Aspirational Districts (Hon'ble PM).
- (13) State Administration and State Police Forces may augment their intelligence capabilities to the district level and beyond and accordingly correlate the same into police training curriculum also. This will help in combating terrorism and divisive forces. (Shri Ajit Doval).
- (14) Development of Universities as centres to inculcate Constitutional values, obligations & duties (Hon'ble PM).
- (15) Competitive Cooperative Federalism between UTs and between States and UTs also (Hon'ble PM).
- (16) Encourage leaders of society to enhance the involvement to improve Ease of Living; generate awareness about Fundamental Duties, particularly among students; and facilitate achievements of SDG goals through convergence with various stakeholders (Hon'ble Governor, West Bengal).
- (17) Need to improve promotion of specific Games at Block level and District level (Hon'ble PM).
- (18) Promoting efficient use of Technology (Hon'ble PM).

I am also directed to request to treat this as Most Immediate and furnish action taken / proposed to be taken on the above recommendations / advice to this office by 15^{th} September, 2020, so as to enable this office to furnish the same to the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India.
